

Baxter Product Security Bulletin

RE: Log4j

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SUMMARY

Baxter is currently monitoring the recently published announcement of a remote code execution vulnerability ([CVE-2021-44228](#)) affecting Log4j Java-based logging library versions 2.0-beta9 to 2.14.1. The Log4j library is developed by the Apache Foundation and is widely used by both enterprise apps and cloud services for logging purposes. The vulnerability has been classified as critical.

RESPONSE

Please note that the Apache Log4j vulnerability is not a Baxter-specific vulnerability. As part of the company's product security policy and protocols, Baxter's team is evaluating Baxter's Java based products and solutions for potential impacts from this reported vulnerability and evaluating further possible actions as needed.

Baxter will continue to monitor all available information and we will provide an update to this bulletin if necessary.
